5. Shall not reveal any trade secret or confidential information and clients which may consequently be detrimental to that clients.
6. Shall participate in professional development programs, such as seminars and workshop, and provide continuous training program to employees to enhance knowledge and working performance.
7. Shall make a reasonable effort to protect and support other members in the association and actively participate in various activities.
